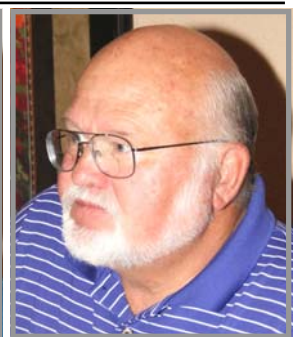

## **Governor Richard Dell'Acqua Citation Requirements**



*To qualify for the Governor' Citation, the club President must confirm in writing that his/her club has complied with 13 of the requirements listed below. The written statement must be submitted between April 17 and May 15, 2010 with a short summary how each requirement was met.*

- 1) Earn the Presidential Citation.
- 2) Increase club net membership by a minimum of 5%.
- 3) Have at least 25% of club membership attend District Membership Seminar.
- 4) Have at least 25% of club membership attend District Foundation Seminar.
- 5) Have at least 20% of club membership attend District Foundation Gala.
- 6) Have at least 30% of club membership registered by May 15 for the District Conference.
- 7) Have at least 30% of club membership attend the District Assembly.
- 8) Have at least two club members complete District Leadership Development Academy.
- 9) Achieve 100% of club membership contributing to The Rotary Foundation at the Sustaining Member level.
- 10) Achieve average \$225 per capita to the Annual Programs Fund in addition to a club average of \$50 per capita to Polio-Plus.
- 11) Become a 100% Paul Harris Fellow Club.
- 12) Have at least 20% of club as members of the Paul Harris Society.
- 13) Sponsor a club Hospitality Suite at the District Conference.
- 14) Have a club display at the District Conference.
- 15) Host at least one GSE International guest, or Youth Exchange Student, or Rotary Friendship Exchange person in a club member's home.
- 16) Sponsor an applicant for any one: Ambassadorial Scholarship, World Peace Scholarship, or a Group Study Exchange Team.
- 17) Participate in at least one Clean Water Project.
- 18) Participate in at least one International Project other than #17, and two significant new Community Projects of your own choosing.
- 19) Conduct a Literacy and/or Numeracy Project in your community.
- 20) Include in the club programs at least one program on each of the following subjects: Membership, TRF, a major local Community Project, International Projects, and Ethics.
- 21) Substantiate the results of at least three club Public Relations Efforts.
- 22) Participate in Rotarians At Work Day.
- 23) Establish Club Trainer, Disaster Preparedness, and a We Care Committee.
- 24) Form at least one of the following to complete the chain: Early Act-Youth Act-Interact.
- 25) Adopt the Club Leadership Plan.
