Besides the wonderful opportunities visiting Birmingham and surrounds, the Preconvention will feature Archbishop Emeritus Desmond Tutu of South Africa June 18. Tutu, a Nobel Peace Prize recipient, will speak about the challenges of peace-building.

**Jane Goodall**, PhD, DBE, founder of both the Jane Goodall Institute for Wildlife Research, Education, and Conservation as well as Roots & Shoots, which is the global humanitarian and environmental youth program that is active in more than 100 countries.

**Clarissa Brocklehurst**, UNICEF's chief of water, sanitation, and hygiene, also will be speaking. Before working for UNICEF, she was a consultant in water and sanitation based in Ottawa, Canada. She's also worked for the World Bank and several other water and sanitation programs.

## News From Our Last Meeting

**Program:** Speaker John Rossi, General Manager Western Municipal Water District provided tons of information. Here's just a little: The District was formed in 1954 to import water to supplement well water. The watershed covered is 527 square miles; they serve a population of 850,000 but will grow to 1.5 million by 2030. They provide annually 125,000 acre feet of water (34 billion gallons); they have 83 storage facilities; the water supplied is 70% state water project, 25% Colorado River Aqueduct water and 5% well water which almost all goes to Riverside. Selected to advance the slides, Pacheco trained Vern didn't need to be told a second time once when to push the right buttons.
